

# NORTHWEST PORTS CLEAN AIR STRATEGY

Port Metro Vancouver (also known as Vancouver Fraser Port Authority) is hosting four community information sessions to share the proposed Northwest Ports Clean Air Strategy (NWCAS) with the public.

The NWCAS is a partnership with Port Metro Vancouver and the Ports of Seattle and Tacoma to address port-related contributions to air quality and climate change in the Georgia Basin/Puget Sound air shed. The NWCAS is part of the Port Metro Vancouver's commitment to environmental stewardship and sustainability.

The NWCAS has been created to reduce port-related diesel emissions in the Georgia Basin/ Puget Sound via voluntary, collaborative means among the three major area Ports. The Ports are working in conjunction with regulatory agencies leading to a collaborative approach for decreasing emissions.
