

Notification to Terminal Operators

TLS Environmental Requirements Vancouver Fraser Port Authority

Please be reminded that the Vancouver Fraser Port Authority (VFPA) Truck License System (TLS) Environmental Requirements will come into effect **April 1, 2008**.

All container trucks must meet VFPA Environmental Requirements in order to continue to access port property. Any truck that has not met the **new environmental requirements** will be instructed to turn around and contact their dispatcher for assistance. Alternatively, they can contact the TLS administrator at 604-665-9333.

The requirements that must be met by March 31, 2008 are:

- All trucks older than 1994 must be opacity tested and passed by March 31, 2008
- In addition to opacity testing, all trucks older than 1989 must also have an approved VFPA age emission reduction measure on their truck.

Guards at VFPA access control gates on the South Shore, Deltaport and Fraser Surrey Docks will turn non-compliant trucks away. Additional patrol vehicles will be available to ensure minimal disruption to port operations and traffic flow.

The VFPA has conducted extensive communications activities since Fall 2007 to ensure that the TLS Environmental Requirements are available and understood. The VFPA also extended the deadline for compliance by 90 days to assist the industry in managing fleet operations while trucks were taken offline to complete their testing.
